




Help NoVo Foundation Build Women's Spaces for NYC!

NoVo Foundation is building two NYC projects dedicated to liberation and equality for women and girls. Women's leadership, participation, and vision will be central to both projects at every stage, from planning to construction and beyond. NoVo is choosing to build Union because we believe in what organized labor can achieve for workers: Dignified work, solidarity, and security for the future.

The Women's Building. NoVo Foundation, in collaboration with Goren Group, is transforming Bayview Correctional Facility, a closed women's prison in Chelsea, into the Women's Building. The Women's Building will be dedicated to justice, liberation and equality for girls and women everywhere. It will provide a hub for the global girls' and women's rights movement. And it will be a living model of the movement's values: collaboration, community, equality, and justice. *Construction begins in 2017.*

Brooklyn Offices. NoVo is redeveloping the former Daytop Building in Boerum Hill, Brooklyn, into its new NYC office. The building will also provide space in Brooklyn for girls' and women's rights activists to gather. *Construction begins in summer 2016.*

We are already speaking with NYC union leaders about how tradeswomen can be involved in both projects. We are excited to work together with you and your unions. We hope to have many women working on both sites, and to create opportunities for women to take on new leadership challenges.
